

## Parcel Tag Guide



Hi, Amy here. I'm one of the Personal Artworkers here at instantprint. We want to make online printing super easy, which is why I've created this guide on setting up your parcel tag artwork for print.



## What Size Should My Artwork Be?



Finished size: 55mm x 85mm 45 degree angled corners 4mm diameter hole

String (optional): 180mm x 7mm x 3mm

Our parcel tags can be printed single or double sided on 350gsm stock. If the tags are going to be written on we recommend uncoated stock.

The tags are available with or without string. The string supplied is white nylon with a plastic snap lock fastener.

If you do decide to print on both sides, you can either upload each side as a separate artwork file or upload them as different pages in the same file. You'll see this option when you add them to your basket.

## How Do I Check My Proof?

Once you've uploaded your artwork, we'll create a proof for you to approve. Nothing gets sent to print until you tell us you're happy with your design.

Please view your proof on a desktop computer or a laptop using Adobe Acrobat or Adobe Reader.

The proof resembles the final printed version; we've removed the bleed and laid a blue cutter on top of the artwork to show where it will be cut.
