Designing a Spread

What is a Spread?

This is two facing pages – one on the left-hand side and one on the right – side by side. Taking folded leaflets as an example, this will be both pieces of artwork on either side of the fold.

Here's what a spread of your artwork should look like for a folded leaflet set up as spreads:



How Do I Set Up a Spread?

The easiest way to set up a spread is to use one of our blank templates. Or if you're creating a document from scratch, use the flat size measurements of your product.

Then simply mark half way with a line or dot (be sure to remove this before you print) and design both pages your pages together.

How Do I Upload a Spread?

If you are using our online proofing tool, all you need to do is upload one side at a time. Side 1 should include the front and back.

Checking a Spread on Your Proof

When you click to view your proof, you'll see a green dotted line down the centre of each spread to show where the fold line will be. Make sure the line is where your fold should be and approve.
